ORDINANCE NO. 1294 AN ORDINANCE Annexing to the City of Rochester, Minnesota, Cartain Plat-ted Land In College View, Olmsted County, Minnesota. The Common Council of the City of Rochester do ordain: Section 1. A petition has been siled-with the Common Council of the City of Rochester, signed by all the owners of the land described herein, requesting the Common Council to annex said isnut to the City of Rochester. The land described in safe petition for annexation is located in achester Township, Olmsted County, Minnesofa and is described as follows: Lots 20, 21, 22, and 23, Block 1, Col-lege View Said petition has also been filed with the Town Board of the Township of Roch-ester, with the County Board of the County of Olmsted and With the Municipal Com-mission of the State of Minnesota and no objections to annexation of the above de-scribed land have been filed with said Town Board or County Board and no objections to annexation of the above de-scribed land have been filed with said Town Board or County Board. Section 2. Section 6. This ordinance shall -take effect and be in force from and after later the same appears more reasonable and actonomical. Section 6.
