
The Municipal Commission acknowledges receipt of

ORDINANCE NO. 153

ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN LAND IN CASTLE
ROCK TOWNSHIP ANNEXED TO THE VILLAGE OF FARMINGTON

The Village Council of the Village of Farmington do
ordain as follows:

Section 1.

That all of the owners of all of the land hereinafter
described have petitioned the Village Council of the Village of
Farmington to have said land included within the Village of
Farmington.

Section 2.

That said land does not exceed 200 acres in area, is
territory abutting on the Village of Farmington, is not included
in any other village or in any city or borough, and is so con-
ditioned as properly to be subjected to the government of the
Village of Farmington.

Section 3.

That it is hereby determined that the annexation of
said land to the Village of Farmington will be, and is, to the
best interests of the Village of Farmington and of the territory
affected.

Section 4.

That there is hereby annexed to the Village of Farmington
all the land lying and being in the County of Dakota and State of
Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

That part of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Township 113
North, Range 19 West lying South of the North 1320 feet as
measured along the East and West lines of said Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$
described as follows: Beginning at a point on the South
line of said Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, distant 440 feet West to the South-
east corner thereof; thence North parallel with the East
line of said Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ 90 feet; thence East parallel with the
South line thereof 240 feet thence North parallel with the
East line thereof 320 feet thence West parallel with the South
line thereof to a point 413 feet West of the West right of way
line of State Trunk Highway No. 3; thence North parallel with
the East line of said Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ 100 feet; thence East parallel
with the South line thereof 250 feet; thence North parallel with
the East line thereof 20 feet; thence East parallel with the
South line thereof to the West right of way line of said State
Trunk Highway No. 3; thence Northerly, Westerly and Northerly
along said West right of way line to the North line of that

part of said Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ lying South of the North 1320 feet; thence West along said North line to the Southwest corner of Sunnyside Addition to Farmington; thence South parallel with the West line of said Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ 639.25 feet; thence East parallel with the North line thereof to a line 654 feet east of and parallel with the West line of said Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$; thence South along said parallel line to the South line of said Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$; thence East along said South line to the point of beginning.

Section 5.

That said ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of Dakota County and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, as required by law.

This Ordinance No. 156 was passed and approved the 25th day of October, 1965, at a special meeting of the Village Council.
