ORDINANCE NO. 234

An Ordinance Annexing Territory Hereinafter Described to the City of Shakopee

WHEREAS, The territory hereinafter described is completely surrounded by land within the municipal limits of the City of Shakopee and as such is subject to annexation to the City of Shakopee pursuant to 414.03 M.S.A., and

WHEREAS, It would be to the best interests of the City of Shakopee and all parties concerned that the said land be annexed to the City of Shakopee, and

WHEREAS, Such annexation is necessary for the immediate welfare of the City of Shakopee and, in order to place the same on the list of taxable properties of the City of Shakopee, this ordinance is declare to be an emergency ordinance.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHAKOPEE DOES ORJAIN:

SECTION I: That the following described property be, and the same hereby is annexed to, declared to be, and does hereby become a part of the City of Shakopee,

to-wit:

All that part of the Northeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter, section 11, Township 115, Range 23, Scott County, Minnesota, bounded by the Hussman Addition on the north and east; the Notermann Addition to the City of Shakopee on the south and on the West by territory annexed to the City of Shakopee by Ordinance #231.

SECTION II: When In Force

As an emergency ordinance, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage.

SECTION III: Filing and Recording

Immediately after the passage and publication hereof, a copy duly certified to by the City Recorder under the seal of the City of Shakopee, shall forthwith be filed with the County Auditor of Scott County, Minnesota; and an identical copy shall be forthwith filed with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota; and an identical copy shall be filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota; and an identical copy shall be forthwith filed for record in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Scott County, Minnesota, and if any of the property above annexed shall be Torrens Title, the copy filed with the Register of Deeds shall then be filed with the Registrar of Titles of Scott County, Minnesota.
