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P R O C L A M A T I O N

- WHEREAS, Bloomington is the home of Metropolitan Stadium and the home town of the Minnesota Twins, 1965 American League pennant winners, and
- WHEREAS, Metropolitan Stadium will be the site of the opening games of the 1965 World Series, and
- WHEREAS, Metropolitan Stadium will be the focal point of an estimated 150 million persons who will follow the World Series via radio, television and the newspapers, and
- WHEREAS, the 1965 World Series will be the first ever played in the great State of Minnesota, and
- WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Minnesota and most state officials will be present at Metropolitan Stadium in Bloomington for the opening games of the World Series,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the State Capitol to be at Metropolitan Stadium in the City of Bloomington from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on October 6 and 7, 1965 during the two opening games of the World Series.
