WHEREAS, the American College of Life Underwriters was founded to produce professionally trained life insurance counselors with high standards of service and ethical conduct, and


WHEREAS, the Chartered Life Underwriters of Minnesota have been devoted to raising the standards of the insurance industry and improving the quality of life insurance service to the public,



in Minnesota.


