WHEREAS, the Minnesota Association of Student Councils is composed of four hundred high schools in the state, and


WHEREAS, delegates from these four hundred schools will be attending an annual convention in Rochester on November 4, 5, and 6, 1965,



and call attention of our adult population to the serious work by our youth in the development of future community leadership.


