PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT NUMBER 1

Amend Section 253, Chapter 21, Paragraph 1, to read as follows:

Section 253. Supplies, Salaries, Report. All supplies for any utility operated by the commission or work required to be done or performed to repair and extend any of said utilities, shall be procured by the commission, but in case the purchase required to be made at any one time shall exceed \$1,000.00 (\$500.00 presently) value, except in cases of emergency, the commission shall invite bids or proposals for the furnishing of the material or supplies upon advertisement as provided for by the City Charter, and the proposals or bids shall be filed with the Clerk of the Commission and shall be by him opened in the presence of said commission, and such contracts shall be let to the lowest responsible bidder, who shall enter into a contract and give security as required by said commission for the performance of such contract. All bills contracted for by said commission in connection with the operation, repair or extension of said plants, and all bills for labor, including all salaries shall be audited by said commission and orders shall be drawn for the amount so audited to the person entitled thereto on the various public utility funds, and such orders when signed by the chairman and secretary of said commission shall be paid by the commission treasurer out of any moneys which may be in the various public utilities funds. All records, transactions, receipts and expenditures of the commission shall be audited annually after the end of the term of office of each and every appointed commission by a (omit "certified") public accountant hired by the commission and paid for out of the public utilities fund.

This amendment shall take effect immediately after passage thereof.

PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT NUMBER 2

Amend Section 91 of Chapter 10, paragraphs 2 and 3
to read as follows:

Section 91.

Paragraph 2. In case such estimated cost does not exceed the sum of \$1,000.00 (\$500.00 presently), the Council may direct that the commodities, labor or service be procured by or through the proper department or officer of the City without public bids.

Paragraph 3. In all cases where such estimated cost exceeds the sum of \$1,000.00 (\$500.00 presently), said commodities, or service shall be furnished or done upon public bids.

This amendment shall take effect immediately after passage thereof.

PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT NUMBER 3

Amend Section 94 of Chapter 10 so as to read as follows:

Section 94. Certified Checks or Bidders' Bonds.

In advertising for any bid the Council shall require bidders to accompany bids with a certified or a cashier's check upon some reputable bank, payable to the City of Eveleth, for at least ten per cent of the total amount bid, which check shall be forfeited to the City as liquidated damages if the bidder upon the letting of the contract to him shall fail to enter into the contract so let.

(The following underlined words to be added.)

In lieu of such certified or cashier's check the bidders may accompany bids with bidders' bonds issued by a reputable bonding company licensed to do business within the State of Minnesota guaranteeing payment to the City as liquidated damages a sum equal to ten per cent of the total amount bid if the bidder upon the letting of the contract to him shall fail to enter into the contract so let. In all advertisements for bids, there shall be reserved the right to reject any and all bids.

This amendment shall take effect immediately after passage thereof.

PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT NUMBER 4

Amend Section 5, Chapter 2, so as to read as follows:

Section 5. Official Year and Term. The official year for the City of Eveleth shall begin at midnight on the first day of January of each year, and the term of office of the Mayor shall be for two (2) years and the term of office of the four (4) Councilmen shall be for four (4) years, except as follows:

In 1966 a Mayor shall be elected for a term of two (2) years commencing January 1, 1967 and ending December 31, 1968.

In 1967 two (2) Councilmen shall be elected for a term of three (3) years commencing January 1, 1968 and ending December 31, 1970.

In 1968 and each two (2) years thereafter a Mayor shall be elected for two (2) years and two (2) Councilmen shall be elected for four (4) years with terms to commence on January 1 of the year following said election, and ending upon their successors having been duly elected and qualified.

This amendment shall take effect immediately after passage thereof.

PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT NUMBER 5

Amend Section 3, Chapter 1, to read as follows:

Section 3. Ward Boundaries. The entire City of Eveleth shall constitute a single ward, but the Council by Ordinance may designate not to exceed eight (8) polling precincts.

This amendment shall take effect immediately after passage thereof.

PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT NUMBER 6

Amend the first paragraph of Chapter 3, Section 20,
so as to read as follows:

Candidates at Primary Election.

Section 20. Candidates to be voted for at any general municipal election in the City, including a Mayor, four Councilmen, Judge and Special Judge of the Municipal Court shall be nominated by a primary election, and no other names shall be placed upon the general ballot than those selected in the manner hereinafter provided. The primary election for such nomination shall be held on the first Tuesday after the second Monday in September commencing in 1966. The judges of the election appointed for the general Municipal election shall be the judges of the primary election, and it shall be held at the same places so far as possible, and the polls shall be opened and closed at the same hours, with the clerks as are required for the general municipal election.

This amendment shall take effect immediately after passage thereof.

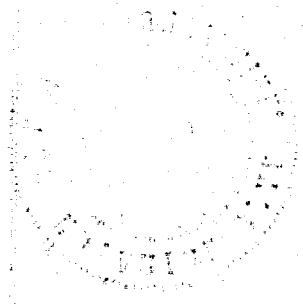
