

REPORT OF MINNESOTA VOTING MACHINE  
COMMISSION MADE OCTOBER 26, 1965,  
ON THE LICENSING OF THE HARRIS IBM  
VOTOMATIC SYSTEM FOR EXPERIMENTAL USE

The Minnesota Voting Machine Commission has licensed the HARRIS IBM VOTOMATIC SYSTEM for experimental use in all precincts in the City of Coon Rapids, Minnesota, for the state-wide general election to be held in the fall of 1966.

It is the opinion of the Commission that the extension of the experiment to the general election of the fall of 1966 will greatly assist the Commission in its ultimate evaluation.

It is the opinion of the Commission that the license for the use of the HARRIS IBM VOTOMATIC SYSTEM by Coon Rapids, Minnesota, in that election complies with the conditions prescribed by L. 1965, c. 619, § 22 (Minn. Stat. 206.212) and by all other pertinent laws of the State of Minnesota, and is therefore approved.
