REPORT OF MINNESOTA VOTING MACHINE COMMISSION MADE OCTOBER 26, 1965, ON THE LICENSING OF THE HARRIS IBM VOTOMATIC SYSTEM FOR EXPERIMENTAL USE

It is the opinion of the Commission that the license for the use of the HARRIS IBM VOTOMATIC SYSTEM by Coon Rapids, Minnesota, in that election complies with the conditions prescribed by L. 1965, c. 619, § 22 (Minn.
