WHEREAS, winter, which has just begun in Minnesota, opens up a host of scenic and sports wonders, and

WHEREAS, skiing is the fastest growing winter sport in Minnesota, with new skiing areas springing up throughout the state, and

WHEREAS, the development of the sport is of great economic value to the entire state, and

WHEREAS, an increasing number of Minnesotans are learning the joy of skiing,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 22, 1965, as

"THE OPENING OF SKIING SEASON"

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to enjoy to the fullest extent winter in Minnesota by skiing.

IN WITNESS WHEREAS, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this nineteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five and of the State, the one hundred eighth.
