

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Jaycees, the Young Republican National Federation and the Young Democratic Clubs of America have joined together in the unique common effort: ACTT-- AMERICA'S CHRISTMAS TRAIN AND TRUCKS for the people of Viet Nam, and

WHEREAS, two million young Americans will be collecting virtually needed food, clothing, medical supplies and school kits to be given directly to the Vietnamese by our soldiers stationed there, and

WHEREAS, a transcontinental ACTT train will leave Washington and move westward to San Francisco gathering gifts for the Vietnamese on the way, and

WHEREAS, the young men of Minnesota from these three groups will be collecting Minnesota's gifts from December 4-11, 1965.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polvaco, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim December 4-11, 1965 as

"AMERICA'S CHRISTMAS TRAIN AND TRUCKS WEEK"

In Minnesota, and urge a most generous response in this expression of our support for the Vietnamese people and of our commitment to their freedom.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this third day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five and of the State, the one hundred eighth.
