

That Section Five of Chapter Five of the City Charter of the said City of Waseca be amended by adding thereto the following subdivision at the end of said Section Five, to-wit:

"Fifty Third.—To establish and operate a municipal coal and wood yard and to purchase coal, wood and fuel and sell the same at retail to the inhabitants of the said city, and for such purpose to lease, purchase or otherwise acquire a site for such yard and to erect such structures and employ such persons and make such contracts as are necessary in the judgment of such Common Council to properly operate said municipal retail coal, wood and fuel yard, and for the purpose of creating a permanent revolving fund for operating said municipal coal, wood and fuel yard, the Common Council may and are hereby authorized and empowered to issue and sell the bonds of said city at such times and in such denominations as the Common Council may determine, but the total amount of bonds issued for such purpose shall not exceed the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00). Such bonds shall be sold for not less than par and shall draw interest at not to exceed 6% per annum, shall run for such period of time as the Common Council of said city may determine, not however to exceed a period of twenty years and may be refunded by the Common Council at the end of such period without a vote of the electors of said city and the adoption of this amendment shall be construed as a vote in favor of and a grant of authority to the Common Council of said city to issue such bonds and as a sufficient authorization for the issuance thereof."
