ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE  
LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MANKATO TO  
INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS  
NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES,  
PURSUANT TO M.S.A., SECTION 414.03,  
SUBDIVISION 2, AND ALL LAWS AMEND-  
ATORY AND SUPPLEMENTARY THERETO,  
AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF  
PROCEDURE OF THE MUNICIPAL COMMISSION

The City of Mankato, Minnesota, does ordain:

I.

A Petition has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Mankato, Minnesota, by the Diocese of Winona, a religious corporation, Celestine A. Hoffman, and Leo J. Hoffman, husband and wife; Independent School District No. 77, a Municipal Corporation, to have such land included in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota.

II.

That they own, in the manner described below, the following contiguous tracts of land, to-wit:

Diocese of Winona, a religious corporation, as contract purchaser, and Celestine A. and Leo J. Hoffman, as fee owners - -

The southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter except the south 150 feet thereof, and the south 150 feet of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter, all in Section 16, Township 108, Range 26, containing 10 acres, more or less, according to the government survey.

Independent School District No. 77 (Mankato, Minnesota) as fee owner--

The southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter except the south 150 feet thereof and the south 150 feet of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter all in Section 16, Township 108, Range 26, containing 10 acres, more or less, according to the government survey,

III.

The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres and is not within the corporate limits

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of any city or village and is contiguous to and abutting upon a portion of the east boundary of the City of Mankato, Minnesota, an incorporated city, having a population of not less than 10,000 nor more than 30,000, pursuant to the last census. That it appears from the records of the Clerk of the City of Mankato, Minnesota, that copies of the petition asking for annexation were filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Mankato Township Town Board, and the Blue Earth County Board, and that more than thirty days have elapsed since said filing and that no objections to said annexation were submitted.

IV.

The City Council of Mankato, Minnesota, hereby determines that the annexation of the above described property will be to the best interests of the municipality and of the land affected and that the above described tracts and parcels of land are so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government and is hereby annexed to and declared to be an addition to the city of Mankato, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof and the corporate limits of the City of Mankato, Minnesota are hereby extended to include said property.

V.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copy of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State, and this ordinance takes effect ten (10) days after its passage and publication and upon the filing of certified copies, as herein described.
