ORDINANCE NO. 65-1

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE PLATS OF MARTINSON'S LOTS, GUSTAFSON'S LOTS AND OTHER LAND IN THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SOUTHWEST QUARTER, SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 62 NORTH, RANGE 18 WEST, TO THE VILLAGE OF COOK.

Section 1: The lands included in the Plat of Gustafson's Lots, according to the recorded plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for St. Louis County, Minnesota, in Book X of Plats, page 29, and the lands included in the Plat of Martinson's Lots according to the recorded plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for St. Louis County, Minnesota, in Book W of Plats, page 33, and a parcel of land 200' x 479.96' as described and set forth in said plat of Martinson's Lots and lying immediately North and adjacent thereto; all of said lands, both platted and unplatted being located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, Township 62 North, Range 18 West are hereby annexed to and made a part of the Village of Cook in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 414.03, the provisions of which section has been complied with.

Section 2: This ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication and filing of a copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.
