ORDINANCE NO. 1014

EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN TO THE WEST.

WHEREAS, the owners of the property hereinafter-described, the Austin Ready-Mix Concrete Company, John Coulston and Gilbert Baldus, filed a Petition requesting the annexation of the territory hereinafter described which was duly presented to the Council,

AND WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is less than 200 acres of platted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough

AND WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all the owners,

AND WHEREAS, no objections to annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed.

AND WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts the City of Austin on the western boundary thereof;

NOW THEREFORE THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN, MINNESOTA DO ORDEIN,

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby determines that the annexation shall be to the best interests of the City and of the territory affected; that the territory described herein abuts the City limits and is urban or suburban in character; and that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

SECTION 2. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the platted land as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, Block 2, Mayer's Sub-Division located in the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 4, Township 102, Range 10.

SECTION 3. The City Recorder is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance takes effect on its passage and publishing and the filing of the certified copies as
