

Ordinance No. 60

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF CHICAGO CITY TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a petition requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on the 25th day of October, 1935; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is platted land no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all owners of property affected thereby; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board or the governing body of any municipalities whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts upon the Village limits at the boundaries thereof.

NOW THEREFORE the Village Council of the Village of Chicago City, Minnesota ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village limits and is about to become urban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. The corporate limits of the Village are hereby extended to include the platted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Lot 44 of Chicago Villas and lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and the North half of Lot 12, Block 43 of Chicago City and lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 in Block 44 of Chicago City and all platted streets lying immediately adjacent thereto.

All according to the plat thereof on file in the office of the Register of Deeds of Chicago County Minnesota.

Section 3. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and County Auditor pursuant to Statute.

Section 4. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.


