ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF AFTON TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCLEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHIREAS, a certain potition dated September 16, 1965, requesting annuation of the territory horoinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 21st day of September, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all the owners of land hereinafter described; and

Williams, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county beard, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHIREMAE, the land described in the petition abute upon the village limits at the Northerly boundary thereof:

The council of the Village of Afton, Minnecota, ordains:

Section 1. The village council hereby determines (1) that the annenation will be to the best interest of the village and of the territory effected;

(2) that the territory described herein abute upon the village limits and is about to become urban or subtrban in character; and (3) that some of said

territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Americal. The corporate limits of the village are hereby entended to include the undetted land described as follows and the came is berely amened to and included within the villege as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

All that part of Lot Seven [7], of Section Twenty-three [28]. Township Twenty-cight (28) North, Range Twenty (20) West of the Fourth Meridian, according to the United States Government Eurvey, doscribed as follows. to-wit:

Deginning at a point in the South line of eard Lot 7 (which also may be described as the Eouth line of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 23. Township 28. Range 20), where the Easterly line of the right of very of the Chicago, Milwankee, St. Paul and Pacific Reliroad Company intersects said South line; thence Northeasterly along the Easterly line of oald right of way 500 feet to a point; thence East on a line parallel with the South line of said Lot 7. 190 feet to a point; thence Southwesterly on a line purallel with the Easterly line of said right of way to the South line of said Lot 7: thence West on the South line of said Lot 7 to the point of beginning.

Section 9. Willing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified corios of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State. and the County Auditor.
