an ordinance extending the corporate limits of the city of impointl to INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATED LAND IN FICEIDING THE EUIDRED ACRES.

The Corner Council of the City of Marshall do ordein as follows:

Section 1. A potition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota by the sole owner of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Hershall, Minnesota:

All that part of the MASWE of Section 3, Township III North, Range 41 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Lyon County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the south right-of-way line of State Trunk Highesy No. 19 constructed and maintained through said Section 3, which is 1,122 feet east of the west quarter corner of said Section 3 and 50 feet south of the center line of said State Trunk Highway, thence southerly at right angles to said right-of-way line 175 feet to point of beginning, thence southerly and at right angles to said right-of-way line 65 feet, thence westerly and parallel to said right-of-way 150 feet, thence northerly at right engles to said right-of-way line 65 feet, thence easterly and parallel to said right-of-way line 150 feet to point of beginning, containing 0.22 acres, more or less.
