ORDINANCE NO. 1221

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALBERT LEA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND AND EXCLUDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ANOTHERWISE OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS.

Introduced by Councilman Fred Bratton

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated November 22, 1966, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on November 22, 1966; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 23.3 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the northwesterly city limits.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBERT LEA, WITNESSETH WHEREBY:

Sec. 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City and of the territory affected (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Sec. 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same to hereby annexed to and included within the City as officially as if it had originally been a part thereof;

Starting at the corner of Section 10, T 102 N, R. 21 W; thence North 1399.4' on the North and South 1/4 line of said Section 10 to the Northwesterly right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 16-65; thence Northeasterly 75.0' on said Highway right-of-way line to a point hereinafter called the point of beginning; thence Northeasterly 319.3' more or less to the Southeastery right-of-way of Stevens Street; thence Northerly 195.0' on said right-of-way line of Stevens Street to the N & S 1/4 line of said Section 10; thence continuing Northeasterly on said right-of-way line of Stevens Street 755.85'; thence 231.6' Southwesterly at a deflection angle of 72° 45' right, to the Northerly right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 16-65; thence Southeastery 330' more or less to a point on the Southeastery right-of-way line of said U.S. Highway 16 - 65, which point is the point of confluence of a curve; thence 333.90' Northerly on said right-of-way; thence 405' Southwesterly at a right angle; thence 310.90' Southwesterly at a right angle to the point of beginning of a curve; thence Southwesterly 770' more or less along a curve with a radius of 2771.60' to a point of intersection of said line with the east line of Buschbom Third Addition; thence Northeasterly along said east line of Buschbom Third Addition to the said Northeasterly right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 16 - 65; thence 130' Southwesterly along said right-of-way line along a curve with a radius of 2366.60' to the end point of said curve; thence 369' more or less Southeastery on a tangent of said right-of-way line; thence 100' Northeasterly at a right-angle to the point of beginning; being a tract in the NE^{1/4}, NW^{1/4}, SE^{1/4}, NE^{1/4} all in Section 10 - 102 - 21.

Above described tract contains 23.3 acres.

Sec. 3 Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Sec. 4 That the above property is hereby zoned as C-2 General Commercial District.

Sec. 5 The road running between Stevens Street and Trunk Highway 16 - 65 in this area be named Prospect Avenue.

Sec. 6 Effective Date. The ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as direction in Section 3.
