PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Consulate General of Israel for the Midwest and the Israel Government Tourist Office have scheduled a series of events to occur in the State of Minnesota during the period January 24th to January 29th, 1966, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this program is to accent the friendly association Minnesota enjoys with the State of Israel, and

WHEREAS, the cultural program arranged for presentation in Minnesota during this period will serve to further the understanding between the people of Minnesota and the people of Israel,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolveng, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period January 24th - 29th to be

"ISRAEL WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge that our people during this period by participation in the programs arranged by the Consulate General of Israel and the Israel Government Tourist Office further their knowledge of the history and development of the State of Israel.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this third day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five and of the State, the one hundred eighth.
