

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, federal employees have set high standards of integrity and performance in the service of their nation, and

WHEREAS, these high standards are made possible by a Civil Service System based solely on merit, and

WHEREAS, each year on the anniversary of the passage of the Civil Service Act of 1923, the American Federation of Government Employees sponsors special programs and activities to acquaint the public with the history and principles of the merit system,

AND, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polvorg, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 16 - 22, 1966, as

"CIVIL SERVICE WEEK"

and do hereby urge the citizens of this state to join with our federal employees in the observance of the eighty-third anniversary of the signing of the Civil Service Act.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fifteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six and of the State, the one hundred eighth.
