NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of January 21st - 30th, 1966, as

"NATIONAL SKI WEEK"

in Minnesota and urge recognition and support for the organizations and areas entertaining and serving the skier.
