PROCLAMATION


- Whereas, the Minnesota Federation of Engineering Societies was formed in 1921 for the purpose of unifying the efforts of all engineering societies in the State of Minnesota in their separate endeavors to improve engineering practice and service in Minnesota, and
- Whereas, throughout the years since then the Federation, working with more than a score of engineering societies, has initiated or cooperated and assisted in movements, practices and legislation which have contributed significantly to the development of Minnesota, and
- Whereas, the Federation is holding its 44th Annual Convention in the City of St. Paul on February 17th - 18th, 1966, and
- Whereas, the theme of the 44th Annual Convention is "LET'S BUILD MINNESOTA," and
- Whereas, the Federation is making a special effort to increase the interest and information of Minnesota citizens, both engineers and non-engineers in improving the economy and welfare of Minnesota, now, therefore I GOVERNOR KARL F. ROLVAAG, do hereby proclaim the week of February 15th - 19th, 1966, as

"LET'S BUILD MINNESOTA WEEK"

and earnestly urge all citizens to make use of this occasion to renew and increase their knowledge and efforts in building Minnesota's economy and people.
