WHEREAS, the National Junior Chamber of Commerce is an organization dedicated to community betterment and individual development for over thirty-five years, and

WHEREAS, in Minnesota there are over 150 local chapters and over 7,000 members, active in such areas as agriculture, community development, health, safety, conservation, international relations, religious activities, governmental affairs, youth and sports, mental health and mental retardation, and
