WHEREAS, the dental health of the citizens of the State of Minnesota is a matter of concern of the citizens themselves, their elected and appointive officials, and the related professional societies, and

WHEREAS, early preventive measures and education of children and youth can aid in preventing a large degree of the incidence of dental disease, especially tooth decay, and can help to ensure the future good dental health of children as they grow to adulthood,

NOW, THEREFORE I, Karl F. Polvay, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 6 - 12, 1966, as

"CHILDREN'S DENTAL HEALTH WEEK"
