PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, I am well aware of youth being one of Minnesota's greatest resources when properly developed and trained, and
- WHEREAS, one of the nationally recognized institutions of this state concentrating on the positive training and development of the male youth has been the Golden Gloves program now in its 35th year, and
- WHEREAS, at the present date over 5,000 young men in the state from 10 to 26 are participating in the program and obtaining physical and mental training and gaining in self-confidence, and
- WHEREAS, the sponsors, coaches and directors are dedicated to the development of all participants, regardless of skills and abilities, and
- WHEREAS, a group of dedicated and unselfish professional and businessmen has come to the rescue and has worked tirelessly to save the program and to expand it so that it will reach many more youth in Minnesota, and
- WHEREAS, during the month of February, tournaments throughout the State of Minnesota will be held and will culminate in the Upper Midwest Golden Gloves Tournament to be held in Minneapolis on February 18 and 21, 1966,
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1966, as

"GOLDEN GLOVES MONTH"

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to participate in and support this program in every way possible as a positive contribution to the needs of our youth.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fifth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six and of the State, the one hundred eighth.
