PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, throughout the United States, more than 1,700 Americans are helping fight the War on Poverty through a unique program called VISTA -- Volunteers in Service to America, and

WHEREAS, for one year these volunteers devote their time, energy, and talent to assisting people who live in poverty areas, for which they receive only necessary expenses and \$600.00, and

WHEREAS, representatives from the National VISTA Office will outline the program and its goals to interested persons in Minneapolis and St. Paul,

AND, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolveng, Governor of the State of Minnesota, in support of this program and in honor of those who are participating, do hereby proclaim January 31 - February 3, 1966, as

"VISTA WEEK"

in Minnesota and urge everyone who has a desire to take an active part in the War on Poverty to investigate the VISTA program.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-seventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six and of the State, the one hundred eighth.
