WHEREAS, 1966 is the sixty-fifth anniversary of the Army Nurse Corps, a vital component in the defense of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, within the Army, the Army Nurse Corps carries out its mission assisting to maintain and conserve the strength of the Army through the special skill of its members, and

WHEREAS, the Army Nurse, displaying a high degree of professionalism, dignity and discipline, has proven indispensable to our nation's Army, both in peacetime and in time of national emergency, and

WHEREAS, presently, a shortage of nurses within the Army had led to a call for qualified volunteers,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvang, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim February 1 - 8, 1966, as

"ARMY NURSE CORPS WEEK"

In Minnesota, and urge all the citizens of the State of Minnesota to give due recognition to the Army Nurse Corps, its aims and traditions.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this thirty-first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six and of the State, the one hundred eighth.
