ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MANKATO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES, PURSUANT TO M.S.A. SECTION 414.03, SUBDIVISION 2, AND ALL LAWS AMENDATORY AND SUPPLEMENTARY THERETO, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE MUNICIPAL COMMISSION.

The City of Mankato, Minnesota, does ordain:

A Petition has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Mankato, Minnesota, by Dorothy A. Madson and Milton A. Madson, husband and wife, as sole owners of the following described real estate, to have such land included in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota, to-wit:

Ι.

The East 394.8 feet of the North 5 acres of SW_2^1 NW_2^1 of Section 16, Township 108, Range 26, excepting the South 30 feet thereof, containing $1\frac{1}{2}$ acres more or less.

II.
