
I hereby certify that a general election held in the city of Gilbert on December 7, 1965 that Chapter 2, Section 6, Entitled Boards and Commissions, Subdivision C Thereof, of the City Charter of the city of Gilbert was amended as follows:

- (c) There may be a Water, Light, Power and Building Commission which may have the same commissioners and officers, until their successors are appointed and qualified, as the Village of Gilbert Water, Light, Power and Building Commission had when this charter became effective, and the Water, Light, Power and Building Commission of the City of Gilbert may function under and be governed by Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Sections 1852 to 1858, both inclusive, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto now or hereafter existing.

The vote being 531 in favor of said amendment and 337 voting against said amendment.
