PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the benefits to our society and our state made possible by the medicare program will have far-reaching effects on the health of older people, and

WHEREAS, March 31 is the last day for older persons to indicate their desire to participate in the voluntary portion of the program,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvung, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of March, 1966, as

"MEDICARE MONTH"

In Minnesota, thereby indicating my deep concern for the rights of our older citizens under this important law, and I strongly urge that all of our citizens who have reached the age of 65 take time to fully inform themselves of the health care protection now available to them under the federal medicare program.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-eighth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six and of the State, the one hundred eighth.
