

Ordinance # 45

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the Village of Hamburg, to Include certain Unplatted Land not Exceeding 200 acres.

Section 1. = A petition having been filed with the governing body of the Village of Hamburg, Minn., by Henry H. Kroells and Mathilda A. Kroells, husband and wife, the sole owners of the following described real estate, to have such lands included within the Village of Hamburg, Minn. to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the North line of Section 33, Township 115 North, Range 26 West, which point is 20 rods West of the Northeast Corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 33; thence running East along the North Section line of said Section 33, a distance of 30 feet to a point; thence turning and running South parallel to the East line of said Northwest Quarter of Northeast Quarter of said Section 33, a distance of 220 feet to a point; thence turning and running West, parallel to the North line of said Section, a distance of 30 feet to a point; thence turning and running North parallel to the East line of said Quarter Quarter, a distance of 220 feet to the point of beginning.

Lying and being in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 115 Range 26, and containing .15 acre of land, more or less.

Section 2. = The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described is .15 acre

Section 3. = The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the Village of Hamburg, Minn., and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village of Hamburg, and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village Government.

Section 4. = Therefore, the Village of Hamburg Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the Village of Hamburg, Minnesota, as affectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. = This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
