ORDINANCE NO. 48

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF VILLERNIE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLEHMIE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA CHDAINS:

Section 1. Patitions have been filed with the Governing body of the Village of Willernie, Minnesota, by all or a majority in number of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Willernie, Minnesota:

Lots Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14), Block Seven (7), Glenmar,, as surveyed and platted and now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Minnesota, and

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6) Seven (7) and Eight (8), Block Six (6) Glenmar, as surveyed and platted and now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Minnesota, and

Lots Five (5) and Six (6) Imsdahl's Rearrangement, County of Washington, as surveyed and platted and now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Minnesota.
