

ORDINANCE #14

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF CLARKS GROVE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN (PLATTED) (UNPLATTED) LAND.

Whereas, a petition has been filed with the governing body of the Village of Clarks Grove, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Clarks Grove, Minnesota.

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast Quarter, (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-four, Township One hundred four North; thence 400 feet West; thence 350 feet North; thence 400 feet East; thence 350 feet South to the place of beginning.

The Village of Clarks Grove does ordain:

Section 1. That the annexation will be to the best interests of Clarks Grove and to the territory affected; that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government.

Section 2. That the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the Village of Clarks Grove as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copies thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State and from and after its passage and publication.
