WHEREAS, Camp Fire Girls commemorates the 56th anniversary of Founders Day, March 17, and Birthday Week, March 20-26, 1966, and

WHEREAS, throughout the years this youth-serving organization has pioneered in programs which benefit girls and prepare them for realistic decision-making and action in anticipation of their assumption of adult responsibilities, and

WHEREAS, alert to the changing times, Camp Fire Girls has effectively served girls of every economic, cultural and social status in communities all over the United States, and

WHEREAS, aware of the expanding interests of girls living in a world which is diminishing in size, Camp Fire Girls will sponsor a land and sea conference in July in which 1,000 girls from 35 states will take part to increase their awareness of Latin American peoples, problems, history, economy and culture,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvåg, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 20-26, 1966, as
