PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the goal of equal opportunity in housing is in strict accordance with our American tradition of personal liberty, and

WHEREAS, March 24-26, 1966, marks the second annual national observance and the first International Conference on Freedom of Residence, and

WHEREAS, this educational campaign focuses on the phrase "Equal Opportunity Neighborhoods" and calls on all people for more positive attention to the values of integrated communities,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of March 24-26, 1966, as

"FREEDOM OF RESIDENCE DAYS"

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to renew their commitment to the basic American principles of freedom and equality.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eighth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six and of the State, the one hundred eighth.
