

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, state and municipal bonds play a major role in providing health, educational and welfare facilities, the foundation of modern communities, and

WHEREAS, these bonds made available today, modern schools, hospitals, roads, airports and recreational facilities, and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Minnesota recognize their responsibilities in providing such needs for the community and that state and municipal bonds have proven to be the most equitable way to obtain these needs,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 17-23, 1966, as

"STATE AND MUNICIPAL BOND WEEK"

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to take this opportunity to familiarize themselves with the workings of our government and to review closely our present needs and those of the future in providing for an expanding population and to do all in their power to assure our community the tools for maintaining community progress.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this sixteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six and of the State, the one hundred eighth.
