ORDINANCE NO. 13  
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERTON, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES, PURSUANT TO M.S.A. SECTION 414.03, SUBDIVISION 2, AND ALL LAWS AMENDATORY AND SUPPLEMENTARY THERETO AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE MUNICIPAL COMMISSION.  
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERTON, MINNESOTA:

SECTION I  
A petition has been filed with the Village Clerk of the Village of Pemberton, Minnesota, by Harry F. Fisher and Mildred C. Fisher, his wife, Duane Hoffman and Gerda Hoffman, his wife, and Evelyn Morzinske, a widow, as fee owners of the real estate herein described, and by Custom Farm Services, Inc., a Delaware Corporation, as joint purchasers of said real estate, to have the following described real estate located in the Township of Meda, Blue Earth County, Minnesota, annexed to and included in the corporate limits of the Village of Pemberton, Blue Earth County, Minnesota, to-wit:

A tract of land in the Northwest Quarter and the Northeast Quarter all in Section 12 of Township 106 North of Range 25 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Blue Earth County, Minnesota described as follows:  
Beginning at the point of intersection of the North line of Section 12 and the Northeast right-of-way line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad a distance of 151.5 feet West of the Northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 12, thence North 90 degrees - 00 minutes East along the said North line of Section 12 to distance of 511.5 feet, thence South 0 degrees - 00 minutes West of distance of 479.1 feet to a point on the Northeast right-of-way line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad, thence North 46 degrees - 52 minutes West along said Northeast railroad right-of-way a distance of 700.9 feet to the point of beginning. Subject to an easement for the township road right-of-way, being 33.0 feet in width and lying South of and adjacent to the North line of the said Section 12.  
Said tract containing 2.4 acres of land more or less excluding the roadway right-of-way.

SECTION II  
The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres and is not within the corporate limits of any city or village and is contiguous to and abutting upon a portion of the southeast boundary of the Village of Pemberton, an incorporated village. That it appears from the records of the Village Clerk of the Village of Pemberton, Minnesota, that copies of the petition asking for the annexation were filed with the State of Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Meda Township Town Board, and with the Blue Earth County Board, and that more than thirty days have elapsed since said filing and that no objections to said annexation were submitted.

SECTION III  
The Village of Pemberton, Minnesota, hereby determines that the annexation of the above described property will be to the best interests of the municipality and of the land affected and that the above described tract and parcel of land is so conditioned as property to be subjected to village government and is hereby annexed to and declared to be an addition to the Village of Pemberton as effectual as if it had originally been a part thereof, and the corporate limits of the Village of Pemberton, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include such property.

- (2) Issued at least five days each week from a known office established in such place for such publication and employing skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same;
- (3) Having all of its press work done in its said known office of publication;
- (4) So made up that at least twenty-five per cent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community which it purports to serve, that it contained general news, comment and miscellany, that it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and that it was not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements;
- (5) Circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local post office;
- (6) Duly qualified as a medium of official and legal publication.

That there is on file in the office of the County Auditor of said Blue Earth County an affidavit by the publisher and printer in charge of the said newspaper, who had knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper; and that the following is a printed copy of the upper and lower case alphabet from a to z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being of the size and kind of type used in the composition, printing and

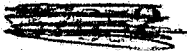
