



FINDINGS OF FACT  
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW  
ORDER

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The above entitled matter was heard by the Court in Regular Term at the Court House at Wheaton, Minnesota, on the 28th of February, 1966. Gordon C. Moosbrugger, Special Assistant Attorney General, appeared for the petitioner and there were no other appearances.

Upon the testimony, records, and proceedings herein, and the files of the Clerk of District Court in the Matter of the Petition for the Organization of a Drainage and Flood Control District, etc., to be known as the Lake Traverse and Bois des Sioux Drainage and Flood Control District, the Court makes the following

FINDINGS OF FACT

I

The Lake Traverse and Bois des Sioux Drainage and Flood Control District was established by order of the District Court, S. A. Flaherty, Judge, on the 13th of October, 1917, with its principle place of business at Wheaton, Minnesota, and contained land in the Counties of Grant, Traverse, Wilkin, Stevens, and Big Stone, pursuant to the authority of Minnesota Statutes 1953, Sections 112.01 to 112.33;

II

No work has been performed during the five-year period immediately prior to the 23rd of April, 1955, nor for many years prior thereto, and no application has been made by such district

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for authority to continue its corporate existence as provided by M.S.A. Chapter 112 within one year after the 23rd of April, 1955;

III

The petitioner has complied with all provisions of law as set forth by M.S.A. Section 112.76 for the termination of said Drainage and Flood Control District.

Based on the foregoing findings of fact, the Court makes the following

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Lake Traverse and Bois des Sioux Drainage and Flood Control District should be terminated as petitioned.

Therefore, the Court makes the following

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the corporate existence of the Lake Traverse and Bois des Sioux Drainage and Flood Control District is hereby terminated as of the date hereof, and it is further ordered that a certified copy of these Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and this Order be filed in the office of the Secretary of State by the petitioner.
