WHEREAS, by encouraging greater participation in the sport, it will aid the campaign to improve the physical fitness of our citizens, and



"PLAY TENNIS WEEK"


In Minnesota and invite the observance of all our citizens to this observance, and to the beneficial aspects of tennis as a lifelong sport.
