I, the undersigned, as Auditor of the County of Washington in the State of Minnesota, do hereby certify that at a Special Election held on the 4th. day of September, 1917, in and for the Village of Dellwood, the following question was submitted to the voters, namely "Shall the Village of Dellwood constitute a separate election and assessment district?"; that the result of said election has been duly certified to me by the council of said Village, and that said question was carried by a majority of the electors of said village casting their ballots at said election, nineteen electors voting "Yes" on said question and no electors voting "No" thereon, and the total number voting being nineteen.

And I do hereby certify the aforesaid result to you, pursuant to law.
