

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the American National Red Cross is recognized as the nation's natural disaster recovery agency and, as such, has demonstrated its ability to meet the needs of families and individuals suffering from disasters, and

WHEREAS, the American National Red Cross is already extending emergency assistance to the citizens of our state during this emergency, and will continue assistance to all those in need until their recovery is assured,

NOW, THEREFORE, I Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby designate the American National Red Cross as the official disaster relief agency in Minnesota for assistance to stricken families and individuals.

I urge all citizens to extend their full cooperation to the American Red Cross in this time of great need. All agencies, both public and private, are requested to extend to the American National Red Cross their full support.

I further urge that all individuals, groups, and organizations desiring to make contributions for the relief of disaster victims send their contributions to our local Red Cross chapters. All such donations will be used by the Red Cross in the humane task of caring for the needs of our people who have suffered loss in the disaster, and who are unable to rehabilitate themselves without assistance.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six and of the State, the one hundred eighth.
