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COUNCILMAN Taylor of the City of Winnipeg, offered the following resolution and moved its  
adoption:

AS SO COMMUNICATED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL AT THE VILLAGE OF KALIKA BAZAR ON THE 15<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 1895.

WHEREAS, the Pine City Development Corporation do the cities of the incorporation described premises, has petitioned the Village Council to renew the property described as follows:

boundary of the Southwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter (S.W. of N.W.) of Section Twenty eight (28), Township Thirty nine (39), Range Twenty One (21); said Line east of the N.P.R.R. described as follows:  
Beginning at a point on the North Line of said S.W. of said  
Section that is 755.9 feet east of the Northwest corner of the S.W. of  
said Section, said point being 200 feet west of the Party  
R.O.W. Line of the N.P.R.R., thence South parallel to the R.O.W.  
Line of the N.P.R.R. a distance of 333.0 feet, thence West parallel  
with the North Line of the said S.W. of N.W. a distance of 200.0 feet  
to the Easterly R.O.W. Line of the N.P.R.R., thence Southwesterly along  
the West R.O.W. of the N.P.R.R. to the South Line of S.W. of N.W. at  
Section 28, Township 39, Range 21, thence east along the South Line  
a distance of 142.2 feet to a point that is 950.0 feet east of the  
Southwest corner of said Party, thence North parallel to the West  
Line of said Party to a point that is 417.0 feet south of the North  
Line, thence east parallel to the North Line of said Party to the  
East Line of said Party, thence north to the Northwest corner of said  
Party, thence west to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, notice of said petition was served upon the Village Clerk of the Village of Pine City, the Town Board of the Township of Pine City, the County Board of the County of Pine and the Legislative Commission of the State of Minnesota,

REEDS, AND THE TOWER (30) DAYS HAVE ELAPSED SINCE THE HOUSE WAS BURNED UPON THE STORE BEACHES, AND NO MAJOR OBJECTS HAVING BEEN SOLD, AND,

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the Village of Pine City to assist said corporation.

**Subdivision 2.** Minnesota Statutes Annotated does hereby amend and reenact before  
described herein as the **Water of Way Act**.
