AN ORDINANCE ANNUALING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO AND EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIBITS OF THE VILLAGE OF VELCOME, MARTIN COUNTY, MINNESOTA

BE IT DROALNED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL O THE VILLAGE OF WELCOME, MINNESOTA, AS FOLLOWS:
