- WHEREAS; the Department of Labor's Neighborhood Youth Corps has been a major force in the war on poverty, and
- WHEREAS, through the Neighborhood Youth Corps the Department of Labor has provided important work-training for the disadvantaged young people of Minnesota, and
- WHEREAS, these boys and girls, 16 through 21, have contributed through this work to the health, beautification and general welfare of Minnesota, and
- WHEREAS, by means of these useful full and part-time occupations, and the wages earned by such labor, many disadvantaged boys and girls have been able to continue their education despite limited family incomes, and
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota citizenry may look forward to having these disadvantaged youths develop into useful, hard-working citizens as a result of Neighborhood Youth Corps training,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of April 17 to 23, 1966, as

"NEIGHBORHOOD YOUTH CORPS WEEK"

and call upon all citizens to acknowledge the superior work of the Neighborhood Youth Corps, to congratulate its members on their achievements, and provide for its graduates full-time permanent job opportunities.
