RESOLUTION

The Legislative Commission received a petition for detachment of land from the Village of Pleasant Lake, Minnesota, on the 23rd day of March, 1966 signed by the said property owners. The Pleasant Lake Village Council voted on a resolution on March 6, 1966 to reject the petitioners' request for the detachment.

The territory involved consists of:

The SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 Section 30, Township 44,
Range 29, Village of Pleasant Lake, County of
Stearns, Minnesota.

The property is unimproved and occupied and is used exclusively for agricultural purposes, and is not needed for reasonable anticipated future development. There are no municipal improvements in said area. The detachment would not unreasonably affect the symmetry of the municipality.

The petition is in proper legal form and sets forth the information required in Minnesota Statutes 414.36 and upon the files and records of the Legislative Commission being fully satisfied in the premises.

It is therefore recommended that the Senator designate said property, and the same hereby is detached from the Village of Pleasant Lake and made a part of the Township of St. Joseph.
