ORDINANCE NO. 1339

AN ORDINANCE Annexing to the City of Rochester, Minnesota, Certain Unplatted Land in the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty-seven, Township One Hundred Seven North, Range Fourteen West, Olmsted County, Minnesota, Which is Completely Surrounded by Land Within the Municipal Limits of the City of Rochester, Minnesota. The Common Council of the City of Rochester do ordain:

Section 1. The following described land in Olmsted County, Minnesota, is completely surrounded by land within the municipal limits of the City of Rochester:

The East 297.0 feet of the West 1287 of feet of the South 440 0 feet of the Northwest Quarter of Section 27, Township 107 North, Range 14 West.

Section 2. The quantity of unplatted land described in Section 1 above is approximately 3.92 acres.

Section 3. The Common Council of the City of Rochester do hereby determine that the land described in Section 1. Is surban in character, is so conditioned as to be properly subject to municipal government, and the annexation of said land will be in the best interests of the City of Rochester and of the land affected.

Section 4. Therefore the land described in Section 1 above is ,hereby annexed, added to and made a part of the City of Rochester. Minnesoria, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.
