
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May as

"MENTAL HEALTH MONTH"


in Minnesota, and commend to the citizens of the state the mental health programs and observances being planned.
