PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the American Foot Health Foundation estimates that two out of three children face the future on unfit feet, and

WHEREAS, because our life span has been considerably lengthened; and

WHEREAS, our nation each year adds a great number of senior citizens, and

WHEREAS, many of these older people suffer from foot disorders, and

WHEREAS, it is the common responsibility of every citizen of the State of Minnesota to contribute to a greater knowledge and understanding of the need for sound foot health as the foundation for the general health and welfare of our nation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby designate the period of May 13 - 20, 1966, as

"FOOT HEALTH WEEK"

and urge that observance of this week throughout Minnesota be signalized by the active participation of all residents, particularly parents, doctors, teachers, nurses, health and welfare groups, channels of communication, and all others, through the dissemination of educational information to create a greater awareness of proper foot health habits in every man, woman and child.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this ninth day of May in the Year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six, and of the state the one hundred eighth.
