ORDINANCE ANNEXING REAL ESTATE  
ORDINANCE NO. 102

WHEREAS, a certain petition requesting annexation of land hereinafter described was duly presented to the council of the Village of Dilworth on the 8th day of November, 1965 and,

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition was less than 200 acres and no part thereof was included within the limits of any incorporated village, city or borough and,

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all of the owners of the real estate involved and,

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and,

Whereas, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits of the Village of Dilworth;

The council of the Village of Dilworth, Minnesota, ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interest of the Village, that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village limits and is urban in character and that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any village, city or borough.

Section 2. The corporate limits of the Village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the Village as effectively as if it had originally been a part of thereof, said land described as follows:

A certain tract of land lying in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Two (2), Township One Hundred Thirty-nine (139) North, Range Forty-eight (48) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, the exterior boundary of said tract of land being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point which lies 1750 feet North of the South One-Quarter point of Section Two (2), Township One Hundred Thirty-nine (139) North, Range Forty-eight (48),

West of the Fifth Principal Meridian; thence Eastward 998.33 feet parallel with the North line of Houge's First Addition to a point which is hereinafter designated as the point of beginning.

Commencing at the point of beginning; thence Northward a distance of 850 feet; thence Eastward and parallel with the North line of Houge's First Addition a distance of 360 feet; thence Southward a distance of 890 feet; thence Westward parallel with the North line of Houge's First Addition 360 feet to point of beginning. Said tract containing 7.37 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file copies of this ordinance with the Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as set forth in Section 3.
